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INNANGELO is a recognized French fashion house known for creating luxury scarves, dresses and accessories, the brainchild of designer Inna Zobova and filmmaker and artist Bruno Aveillan. Born out of their talents, passion and their shared experience in the fashion and luxury world, INNANGELO fuses the artistic avant-garde with the noblest artisan tradition.

The launch of INNANGELO took place only a year ago at the iconic Parisian concept store Colette, during the FIAC week, bridging the specific positioning of the brand between Fashion and Contemporary Art. The first collection, featuring twenty scarves and sarongs in limited edition, was unveiled in the famous front window of 213 rue Saint Honoré. The front window was transforming daily, presenting multiple scarves designed by Inna with complimentary installations by notable contemporary artists, exhibiting the essence of their collaboration with INNANGELO.

All INNANGELO's creations are designed in Paris and hand-crafted in the workshops of the legendary House of Ratti, located on the shores of Lake Como. Over the last 70 years, Ratti has worked to magnify silk and other natural fibers by applying its extraordinary savoir-faire and high standards to every step involved in the creation of fabrics. Today, Ratti works with major designers and only the most distinguished international fashion labels.

INNANGELO was met with critical acclaim in more than 40 editorials, articles and covers such as: VOGUE, CITIZEN K, ELLE, Marie Claire, AIR FRANCE Magazine, Le Monde Magazine, Harpers Bazaar, ZINK, The New York Times Magazine, Glamcult, AMICA, The Guardian. INNANGELO was immediately distributed in selected concept stores such as Colette (Paris), Bernard Orcel (Courchevel), GUM Section (Red Square Moscow), Edgar (Saint Barthélémy), and Bloomingbirds (Aspen).

This coming season, with the success of the scarf line, INNANGELO will launch a signature collection of tunics and kaftans, inspired by the ethic of INNANGELO's colors and design aesthetic.

As a testament to its success, in its inaugural year, INNANGELO has been embraced and worn by such high-profile personalities such as: actors Leonardo DiCaprio, Monica Bellucci, Guan Xiaotong, singers Alicia Keys, Mylène Farmer, Sting, Beth Ditto, Swiss Beatz, and supermodels Karlie Kloss, Soo-Joo Park, Lara Stone, Natasha Poly, Doutzen Kroes and the newly named star dancer of the Paris Opera, Germain Louvet.

Most excitedly, Inna Zobova's and Bruno Aveillan's curation and creations have also made significant impact across the cause-related sector. As ambassadors of The Heart Fund, INNANGELO is committed to the fight against heart disease in children, donating a percentage of its profits to the foundation.


Collaborations with artists

From the outset, INNANGELO has nurtured long term relationships with contemporary artists, inviting them to discover and express their creativity in the world of precious silks and rare textiles. Every limited edition scarf created by each artist for INNANGELO comes with a specific packaging and a numbered certificate of authentification hand-signed by the artist.


Richard Texier, one of the few of contemporary artists to have had an entire issue of the prestigious Art Press Magazine dedicated to his work, created an exclusive series entitled ECLIPTICA, UMBRA TERRA, and THEORIA SACRA, limited to one hundred pieces per print.

Mircea Cantor, the 2011 winner of the Marcel Duchamp Prize was ranked in the top ten of worldwide artists in 2017 by Journal des Arts. Mircea's works are included in the collections of many major museums around the world, from New York's MoMA to the Minneapolis Walker Art Center to the Beaubourg Center in Paris. The artist has designed three scarves in limited editions entitled YOU FIRE ROPE ME, YOU RAINBOW ROPE ME, and YOU INDIGO ROPE ME. All of which will be unveiled at FIAC 2018.







